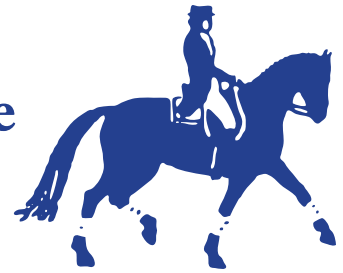

CTDS subscribes to USA Equestrian policy regarding safety equipment: "All juniors must wear protective headgear passing testing standards while riding in designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring, and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Headgear must be secured and if the headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at anytime must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place." Adults are encouraged to comply with this rule, however, it is not mandatory—remember adults set the example for the juniors.
